The Springfield Police Division is once again preparing the "SAFETY CITY" course for this summer. "SAFETY CITY" has been planned as a five-day course in safety education for all children who will be attending kindergarten or first grade in September. "SAFETY CITY" is designed to teach children traffic safety, safety in the home, seatbelt safety, fire safety and stranger safety. The 2010 "SAFETY CITY" class had an enrollment of over 400 boys and girls. It is anticipated that this year the attendance will be even higher, so be sure to register early.

In our efforts to make "Safety City" a more memorable and fun filled experience for your child, we have many features this year. Some of those include fire safety trailer, photo ID cards, three safety robots and a custom designed safety course complete with miniature Springfield landmarks to drive their cars around.
