

Maintenance

Our maintenance staff is responsible for maintaining equipment operability through preventive maintenance, equipment replacements, equipment modifications or any number of other tasks to ensure that our plant is operating at maximum capacity and maximum efficiency on a continuous basis. Preventive maintenance is important to prevent equipment failure at times when that equipment is most needed. As equipment wears out, it must be rebuilt or replaced. When a system does not operate as intended, it may require modification. Our qualified maintenance staff possess the abilities and tools to do the work and think through problems.



The maintenance staff consists of various abilities and specialties. Three Maintenance Mechanic II personnel perform the more technical aspects of maintenance and repair. Two Maintenance Mechanic I personnel perform routine tasks and aid the Maintenance Mechanic II workers. We also have two electricians on staff to conduct repairs to the PLC system, various motors, valve operators and other electrical systems and components. Supporting staff also includes a Belt Filter Press Operator, a seasonal grounds keeper and a custodian. The maintenance staff work from 7:00am to 3:30pm Monday through Friday.
